


Driver suffers damaging stroke following motor vehicle collision

In November 2018, Steven Glenn was driving on Interstate 95 in Florida. Suddenly coming upon a multi-vehicle accident and beginning to slow down, Steven was rear-ended by another vehicle. He suffered severe injuries in the collision including a cervical herniation that impinged on his carotid artery requiring surgery. Shortly after surgery, he had a stroke which further debilitated him. Steven contacted SDSBS attorney **Mara Hatfield** requesting her help in holding the at-fault driver accountable for his injuries. Ms. Hatfield was able to demonstrate that the stroke was directly related to the type of herniation suffered in the accident. Prior to suit, Ms. Hatfield reached settlement with the at-fault driver's insurer. ♦
